間接疑問文

Q1) Who is that man? ⇒「 」

Wh で始まる疑問文は、"Do you know" や "Please tell me", "I wonder" などの別の文とつなげて使うことができます。

例えば、"Do you know" とつなげる場合は、疑問詞が主語になる場合(who speaks)などを除いて、疑問詞の後の語順が肯定文と同じように「 S+V 」になります。つまり↓

上のように、疑問詞が別の文の一部になった形を間接疑問文と言います。間接疑問文は名詞の役割をします。

Ex)

Whose pen is this?

I don't know + Whose pen is this?

I wonder + Where is Olivia?
